

## Live Music Pioneers [nugs.net](http://nugs.net) Launch Streaming Service

### New Service Features Thousands of Concerts from Pearl Jam, Phil Lesh, Umphrey's McGee, Widespread Panic, and Many More

nugs.net, the digital music company that invented the authorized live music download world over a decade ago, launched their first subscription streaming service today. The service launched with 10,000 professionally recorded concerts. Dedicated live music fans will now be able to flock to the latest shows available.

The launch includes a passel of shows from the most recent Halloween — always one of the most anticipated music nights of the year — including sets from Phil Lesh from the Capitol Theater, Umphrey's McGee from the Riverside Ballroom in Milwaukee, and Widespread Panic from the US Cellular Center in Asheville. There are also more than 50 classic Halloween shows from the vaults.

The mobile streaming service, eponymously named [nugs.net](http://nugs.net), launched with native iOS and Android apps, which can be accessed at <http://nugs.net/app>. There is a seven-day free trial for the subscription service, and pricing is \$12.99 per month for unlimited access to the app's catalog of live sets, or \$129.99 per year. Non-subscribers can listen to a rotating selection of featured shows, plus a free stream of [nugs.net](http://nugs.net) radio, a 24x7 playlist of cherry-picked live tracks from [nugs.net](http://nugs.net)'s extensive archives.
